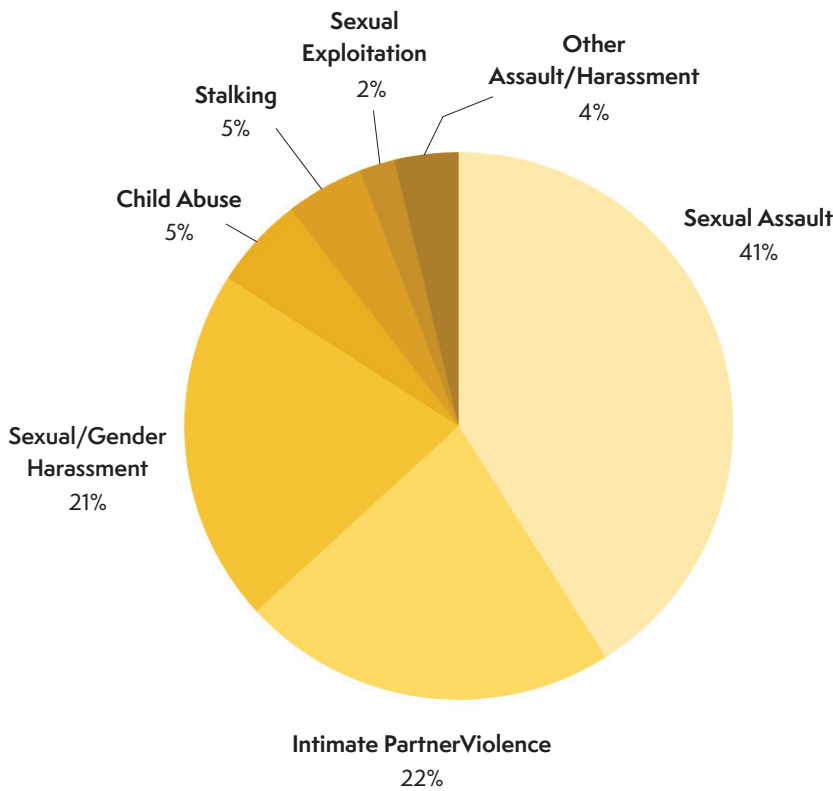

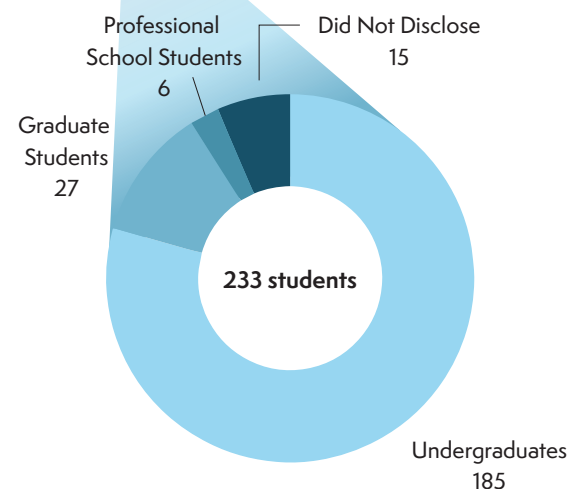
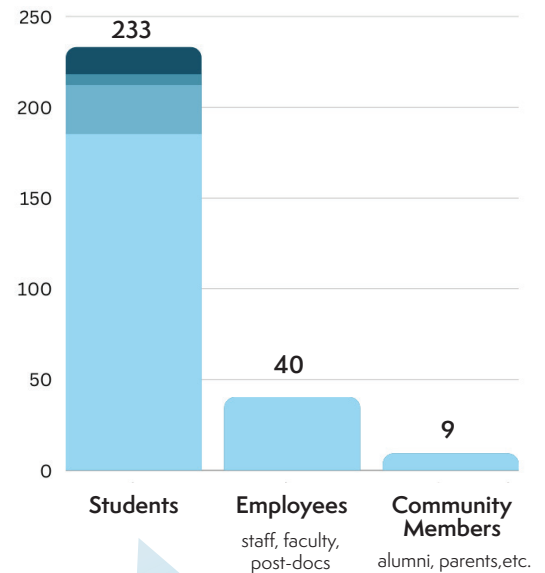

Incident Types



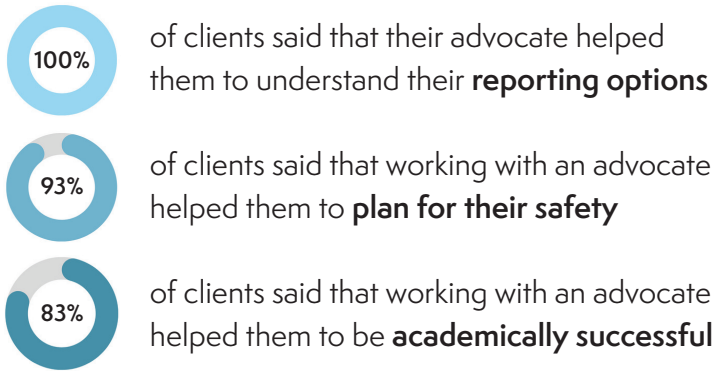
