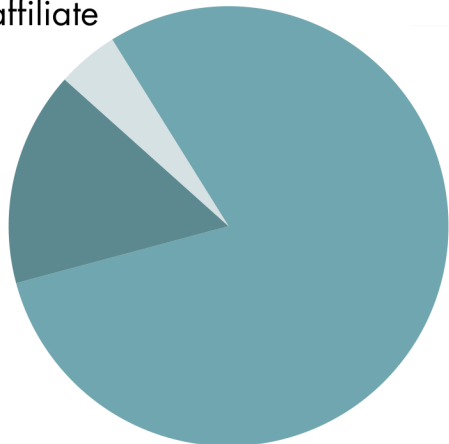

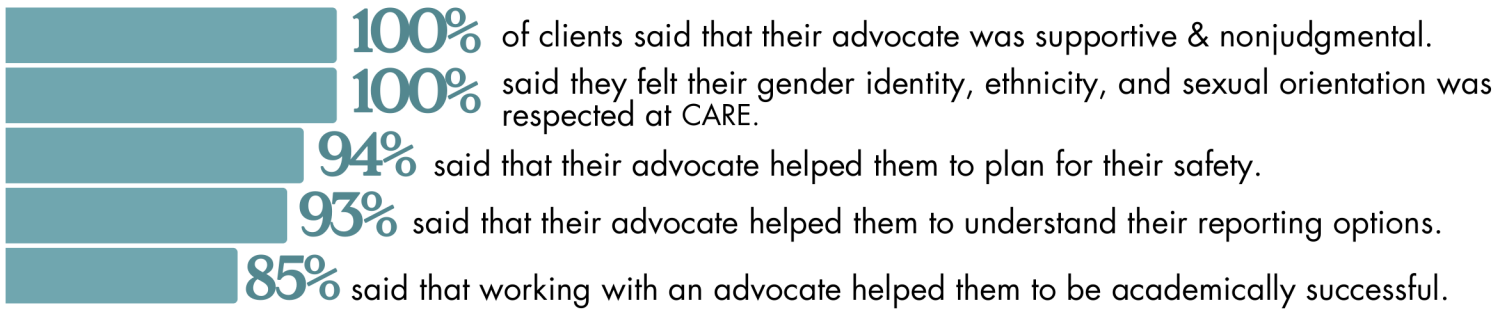
Incident Types

Prevention Education, Training, & Outreach

Over 180 hours spent participating in collaborative and multidisciplinary meetings, and serving on local and systemwide committees.

In 2023, CARE received approval to hire an additional victim advocate on a contract basis, bringing the total number of victim advocacy staff to 3, and the total FTE to 8 career staff and 2 part-time student assistants.
